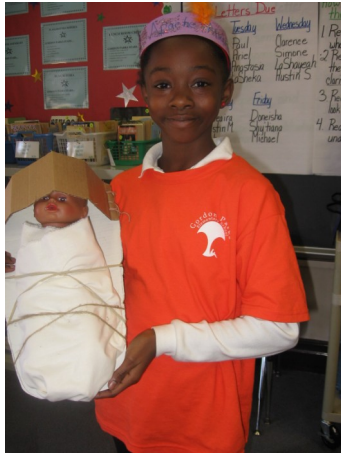




# 2010 - 2011 Annual Report

# 2010 - 2011 Report Card



## Communication Arts

Through the efforts of Supplemental Reading Teacher Stephanie Hawkins, and the Balanced Literacy approach to curriculum teaching, Gordon Parks achieved strong growth in communication arts during the 2010 - 2011 year:

- The number of students reading at or above grade level increased from 47% in August 2010 to 80% in May 2011.
- Gordon Parks students showed an average increase of 60% on reading units during their course of the school year, growing from an average 14% comprehension on pre-assessments to 73% on post-assessments.



## Mathematics

Building on the strong growth achieved in mathematics comprehension during the 2009 - 2010 year, Supplemental Math Teacher Karen Brunk worked side-by-side with teachers and students to ensure that the Math Investigations curriculum was fully integrated into classrooms. This program emphasizes the use of manipulatives as way to teach mathematics lessons.

- The average score on math unit assessments during the 2010-2011 school year increased from 10% (pre-test) to 76% (post-test).
- Gordon Parks began the school year with 20% of students scoring proficient or advanced on their math fluency test. By May, 64% of students scored proficient or advanced - an increase of 44%.



## Integrated Arts

Students are engaged each week in the studies of art, music, and physical education. These special classes enhance the process of learning by developing students' sensory, cognitive, emotional, and motor capabilities.

- The Fine Arts Friday program continued during the 2010 - 2011 school year, with students participating in field trips to the Nelson-Atkins Museum, art-related math and reading activities, and special performances by local musicians.
- The physical education program focused on increasing the fitness level of students. Based on pre-test and post-test results, third through fifth grade students' fitness levels improved on average by 81%.



## Aftercare Program

The Gordon Parks Aftercare Program provides students the opportunity to participate in cost-free after-school enrichment and curricular activities in a safe and nurturing environment. In addition to tutoring and homework help, the program offers activities in the areas of academics, athletics/creative movement, and character building.

During the 2010 - 2011 Aftercare Program:

- Students logged nearly 3,000 hours of remedial instruction, receiving supplemental academic support in math and communication arts.
- Special activities included Martial Arts, African drumming, Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, Pets for Life, and Debate Team.
- 13 girls in the third through fifth grades completed the Girls on the Run program, funded by the Junior League of Kansas City. The program included training two times a week, a curriculum that focused on self-esteem, and participation in a special 5K race.



## Special Needs

One-third of the Gordon Parks student body is enrolled in the Special Needs Program. Services include Special Education, Occupational Therapy (OT), Vision Skills Therapy, Speech/Language Pathology, and Integrated Listening Systems (ILS). Many of the students who benefit from the supportive services technically do not qualify for special education under Missouri regulations. However, as a school dedicated to the conviction that “every child has promise,” Gordon Parks serves all students who can benefit from Special Needs services.

Highlights from the 2010-2011 year include:

- 88% of ILS students met all of their goals and 100% of students met at least 2 of their 3 goals.
- 93% of ILS students made solid reading progress.
- 80% of students in OT reached 80% of their stated OT goals.



## Counseling/Behavior

The Counseling and Behavior programs served 48 students (23% of student body) during the 2010-2011 academic year. Two certified counselors provide individual and small group mental health support to students and their families. The counselors also became Certified Trauma Specialists during the 2010 - 2011 school year. Gordon Parks uses the Behavior Intervention Support Team (BIST) approach to behavior management.

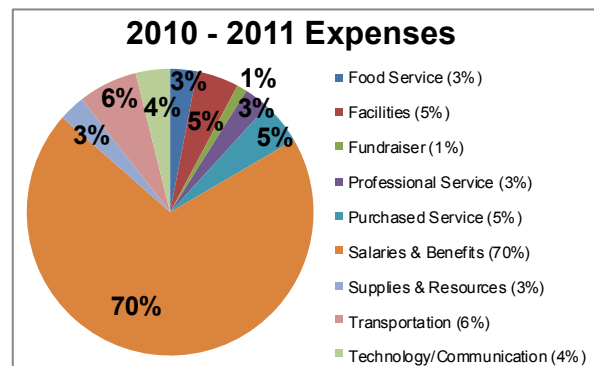
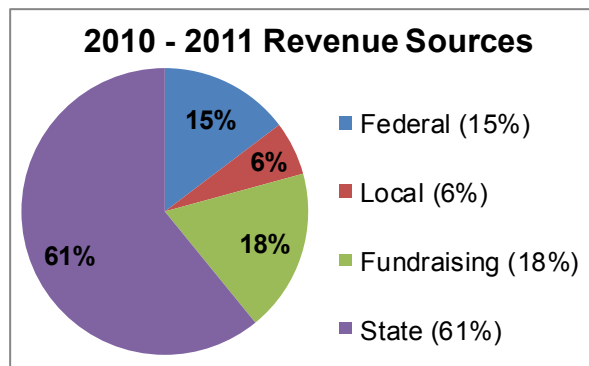
The students who participated achieved excellent therapeutic results:

- 74% of individual therapy students met all goals of treatment. The remaining 26% of students met 2 out of 3 treatment goals.
- 82% of group therapy students met all goals of treatment. The remaining 18% of students met 2 out of 3 goals of treatment.
- 86% of students in the Counseling program decreased their depression index score during the school year.
- 69% of students in the Counseling program reduced their negative behavior Care Room visits over the course of the year.
- 77% of families whose students are enrolled in individual therapy actively participated in their child's mental health therapies and were in regular contact with the school counselors.



## Financial Statement

Gordon Parks Elementary began the fiscal year 2010 - 2011 with a budget of \$3,157,000 and reserves of \$586,349 (18% of budget). Reserves increased this year by \$159,931 for an unaudited reserve balance of \$746,280 at 6/30/2011.

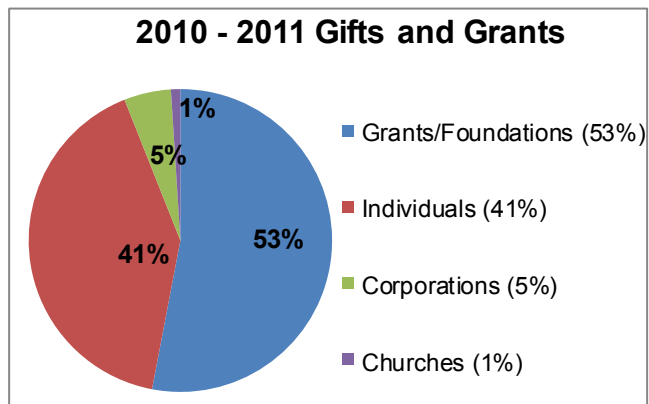
# Community Support

## Development

Only 80% of Gordon Parks Elementary's operating costs are paid by governmental funds leaving the school to fundraise the remaining 20% each year. During the 2010 - 2011 school year, Gordon Parks raised \$620,042 through contributions from grants and foundations, individuals, corporations, and churches. These generous contributions allow our school to support the small class sizes, integrated arts program, and intensive support services that are vital to our students achieving in the classroom.

Highlights from the 2010 - 2011 year include:

- **470 active donors** contributed to Gordon Parks this year (a 23% increase over last year), including 190 new donors and 64 reactivated donors.
- Over 50 individuals visited our school, participating in a Breakfast Learning Walk or individual tour.
- We honored 40 donors in May at the **Gordon's Gathering** luncheon for their unrestricted gifts of at least \$2,100 during the 2010 - 2011 year.
- The annual Fall Fundraiser, "Field Day," raised **\$121,600** to help fund our small class sizes, intensive support services and integrated arts program.



## Volunteer Program

Gordon Parks' active volunteer program successfully integrates volunteers and community partners into its classrooms, programs, and annual events. These dedicated volunteers work side-by-side with teachers and staff to help ensure that students achieve their academic goals. In addition to the more than 300 individuals who serve at the school, Gordon Parks appreciates the contributions of the 27 community organizations who contribute their time, talents, and resources to our students and staff members.



During the 2010 - 2011 year, volunteers:

- served more than **5,000 hours** by tutoring students, plating and serving lunches, serving as one-on-one mentors, and supporting administrative projects.
- prepared **over 6,000 newsletters** and **3,000 holiday cards** for mailing.
- supported many **special school events** like the Fall Fundraiser, Holiday Bazaar, Fifth Grade Ladies' Tea, Field Day, and student achievement parties.



## Family Outreach

The addition of a new Family Outreach Coordinator position during the 2010 - 2011 school year placed a greater emphasis on increasing family involvement in school activities and programs.

- Special **school programs** like Family Math Night, Grandparent's Day, Middle School Fair, and Literacy Night provided family members the opportunity to learn alongside their students.
- The **Parent Advisory Committee** met every second Tuesday of the month and had between 7 - 16 family members participate each month. The meetings provided an opportunity for parents to help make decisions that impact their students.

- Gordon Parks achieved a **93.1% attendance** rate.
